# Summer Concert 2017 Programme

## CONCERT BRASS DIRECTED BY SUSAN DURANT

### *For Your Eyes Only by Leeson/ Conti arr. Ramskill*

This is the title theme from the 12th James Bond film starring Roger Moore, appearing in the opening film sequence. This arrangement starts quietly with an introduction before the theme is introduced by the horn and trombone.

### *Rhumba by Bruce Fraser*

This piece starts with percussion introducing the rhumba rhythm, later joined by the baritones. The trumpet plays a decorative melody over the top. There is a further melody played by the horn and trombone before the trumpet melody returns.

### *Go Tell it on the Mountain Trad arr Ramskill*

This jazzy arrangement of the spiritual gives the 2nd trumpets a rare chance to play the melody line while the 1st trumpet accompanies them.

## CONCERT STRINGS DIRECTED BY HELEN WILLS

### *Drowsy Maggie (traditional arr. Wills) and Devil Amongst the Tailors (traditional arr. Wills)*

Folk tunes with catchy tunes and fast string- crossing.

### *Lemon Twist by Doug Spata*

This 1950's inspired rhythmic piece with a chromatic melody moving between all instruments, complicated by clapping!

### *Wraggle Taggle Gipsies arr. Rory Boyle*

Another folk tune, with the melody at half speed in the middle section.

## FLUTE CHOIR DIRECTED BY CLAIRE HINDLE

### *Menuetto in D major, by Mozart*

This is from the Haffner Symphony of 1782. It requires great articulation, expressiveness and tonal control.

### *Rondo Finale, by W Gabrielsky*

This is a lively piece, and we are fortunate to have many expert soloists in the flute choir. Hannah Capstick will be playing the solo in this piece.

## CLARINET CHOIR DIRECTED BY MARINA KUMMER

### *Hushabye Mountain by Sherman arr Orriss*

This exquisite little arrangement is deftly designed to expose some favourite clarinet bugbears. Listen out for quiet legato octave leaps and reed control around the melody, which is shared between all lines.

DIRECTED BY JANE ANDERSON BROWN

### *Minuet and trio by Mozart*

from set of pieces for three flutes, which are possibly a reworking of an earlier set of pieces for three basset horns.

## **YOUTH STRINGS DIRECTED BY GOSKA KOSMACZEWSKA**

### *Sonata da Camera for Three Violins and Two Cellos in two movements by Zannetti.*

The first movement is like a mini concerto for cello. Today our soloist is Mollie Leggett. The second movement is in form of a fugue. Francesco Zannetti (1737-1788) was an Italian composer, violinist and singer.

First movement "Allegretto" from Palladio - Suite in three movements by Karl Jenkins. Allegretto (1993) became well known when it was used for a TV commercial for diamonds. Palladio was inspired by the 16th century Italian architect Andrea Palladio.
